TEAM & TEAM CAPTAIN'S RESPONSIBILITIES

THE TEAM MEMBERS SHOULD VOTE AND ELECT ONE OF THEIR MEMBERS AS THE CAPTAIN. A TEAM MAY ELECT A NEW CAPTAIN BY VOTE AT ANY TIME, THE CAPTAIN MUST HAVE A PHONE, THE WHOLE TEAM IS STILL RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DUTIES OF THEIR CAPTAIN, THESE DUTIES INCLUDE:

- A. Verifying that all team members are valid APA members of legal age, 18 years old, and abiding by APA Rules & the Local By-laws (SEE BY-LAWS FOR MEMBERS UNDER 21 YEARS OLD)
- B. That all team members are playing at the skill level that reflects their true ability and not sandbagging. *The team may be disqualified for a member cheating*.
- C. Collecting membership fees (\$25.00 per member, per year) and *team weekly fees* (\$35.00, regardless of matches played) from members and / or the team sponsor and forwarding the fees to the league management on night of play by putting in the team envelope.
- D. Distributing league information, newsletters, and informing players of any rule changes, tournaments, or APA events.
- E. Informing teammates and their Host Location of the next scheduled match-site and time especially for the Division Playoffs.
- F. Making sure proper score keeping procedures are followed, *score sheets* are checked for correctness, and score sheets are turn-in, in a timely manner.
- G. The team captain (not the players) should communicate with the league management. The team captain represents the team and is elected by the team. A newly elected team captain should notify league management of the change.
- H. Captains must be responsible for the over-all behavior of the team, guests of team members, and / or patrons in their host locations. Captains should notify the host location's management of problems with patrons at their establishment during league play.
