2012 – 2013 Jack & Jill's Open 8-Ball Doubles Rules

Final Tournament: Saturday February 23, 2013

- 1. All APA 8-Ball Game rules apply.
- 2. One coaching time-out per team per game will be allowed.
- 3. Alternate Shot
 - a. Once established the rotation remains the same throughout all games.
 - b. The winner of the lag breaks, losers shoot second.
- 4. Only combination of male & female allowed on teams.
- 5. Modified Single Elimination Tournaments will be used for all qualifiers and the final tournament, qualifying two (2) teams.
- 6. Skill Level of 10 or less.
 - a. If combined SL raises to 12, team will advance.
 - b. If combined SL raises to 13, team will pick new partners and play off for slot.
 - c. Players will play at current handicap February 23, 2013 or handicap when qualified, which ever is higher.
- 7. Players must have twenty (20) 8-Ball scores by February 23, 2013.
- 8. Players must have an active APA membership when qualifying.
- 9. Players must be on an active APA 8-Ball roster Spring Session 2013.
- 10. A team may enter a qualifying tournament at any time as long as a Bye is on the tournament board.
 - a. A new team must pay full entry fee even if the team only has a single elimination.
 - b. An eliminated team may reenter by paying full entry fee if a Bye is still on the tournament board after their elimination.
- 11. If a team member leaves the APA after qualifying or qualifies again with another partner the remaining member may pick another partner of the same handicap.

 ****(New Partner must have play in at least two (2) Jack & Jill Doubles Qualifiers)
- 12. If both team members leave the APA the next qualifying team will get the slot.
- 13. If there are more than 24 teams in a single tournament we will qualify 4 teams
- 14. A Final Invitational Tournament will be held for Teams that were eliminated by Single Elimination or attended the most qualifying tournaments W/O qualifying
- 15. There will be at least 24 teams in the final tournament. If 24 teams have not qualified the teams that have played the most will be allowed to play.
- 16. If a team fails to go to the National Jack & Jill Doubles Championship the team will repay the travel fund to be used for the next place team or held for the next years travel fund.
