Higher Level Tournament Qualifying Criteria

In order for a player to advance to any level of the National Team Championships (including the Local Team Championship) he/she must meet certain criteria. This Higher Level Tournament criteria is listed below.

► Must have a skill level based on at least 10 actual League match scores in the format in which the player is advancing. These scores include normal weekly play and play offs scores.

Must advance with the highest session-ending handicap he/she had from the time his/her team becomes qualified to his/her Spring Session ending handicap. (Highest session ending must also be based on 10 actual League match scores in the format in which the player is advancing.)

Must have played at least four times with the qualified team in the Spring Session.

Must maintain current APA membership status.

► Must be on a team that has at least four original members from the session qualified.

► Must have either joined an already qualified team (20 actual League match scores to join an already qualified team in the Spring Session); or be a member of a team that won a division title, a member of a team that won the Most Matches in their division, or finished behind an already qualified team that re-qualified to gain entry into HLT.
