

Late and No-Show Teams

No Show Teams:

If a team fails to show for a scheduled match and fails to let anyone know prior to play time the league office will probably not be able to correct anything before league play should start. **JUST NOTIFY THE LEAGUE OFFICE AND WE WILL PROBABLY TELL THE CAPTAIN TO SEND THE TEAM HOME.** The league office will need some time to find out what happened.

Unless the opposing team wants to schedule a make up match a team that fails to show without 24 hours prior notice will be considered a forfeit. No make up matches will be allowed in the final three weeks of session whether teams agree or not.

Consideration and bye points may be given to a team that fails to show because of an extreme emergency.

Late Teams:

A team is considered late 20 minutes after Start time:

At 15 minutes past Official Starting Time.

First call the League Operator at (910) 868-8514 or cell: (910) 494-3951

Have the bartender make an announcement asking the opposing team.

A Team only must have one (1) members present to start the match.

By-laws

“A team must have a player at the table and ready to begin within 20 minutes of the appointed time. At 15 minutes a member of the team that is present will themselves or have the bartender make an announcement asking for any members of the opposing team. **A member of the team that is present at 15 minutes past the appointed time will also call the League Operator at (910) 868-8514 or call the LO at (910) 494-3951 on his cell phone to make the forfeit call.**

Bye / Forfeit.

Any team failing to play a scheduled match two weeks in a row will be dropped and a bye will be put in the schedule or a new schedule will be issued. In the first 4 weeks teams given 5 forfeit points for a team that eventually drops will have the points adjusted to 3 points in 8-Ball and 60 bye points in 9-Ball and the fees paid will be returned to the teams.

After the 5th week only the two weeks that the team was a no show will the opposing teams get Bye points and have their fees returned.

Any team failing to show, pay, or playing less than 3 matches for the last scheduled match of the session will be considered dropped and only 3 bye points will be awarded for 8-Ball and 60 bye points for 9-Ball. The dropped team will not be eligible for the Wild Card Draw.
