

THE TEAM CAPTAIN

The team Captain is The Team Captain - The Team Captain is an essential part of the team and holds an important position.

The Team should elect a Team Captain by simple majority vote.

The Team Captain is the first person listed on the team roster.

The League Operator must approve the designated Team Captain.

(If the elected Captain was a Captain before and had problems they may not be approved.)

The Team Captain must have a phone.



THE TEAM CAPTAIN IS RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Collecting membership fees and League dues and sending these to the League Office.
- Verifying that all team members are valid APA members with only one APA record, of legal age, and play their true skill level.
- Having the team at the right place and time for your matches.
- That all rules concerning etiquette and sportsmanship are observed by the team and their guests
- Making sure proper score keeping procedures are followed.
- Communicating any team issues, inquiries, or complaints to the League Office. The Team Captain is the only person who will communicate with the League Operator on all team issues and information.
- Distributing important League information to the team and posting it at his home location.

A team may elect a new Team Captain by a simple majority vote at any time. Local League Management must be notified immediately if a new Team Captain is elected.
